

What is ILTI & the Cross-Campus Enrollment System (CCES)?

UC Cross-Campus Enrollment continues to expand as more online courses are developed and offered. High-quality online courses developed and taught by faculty across the UC system increase opportunities for students to take courses they need to graduate on time. All courses earn UC unit credit, with the potential for GE, pre-major or major credit based on campus, departmental, and programmatic requirements.

How will these courses help UC students?

- **Expand access** to needed courses that are over-enrolled, or otherwise unavailable to your students.
- **Increase opportunities** for students to take new courses not currently offered on your campus or during the current term.
- **Offer unique learning environments** where students can engage and interact with students and faculty at other campuses.

Students can take an online course from UC Merced on thermodynamics, a UC Santa Cruz course on the geology of national parks, and an education course from UC Berkeley that features opportunities for students to create content collaboratively and provide feedback to peers.
