## Students need help!

Here are ways you can help...

1. Diagnose enrollment problems 2. Resolve when possible 3. Refer appropriately

## DIAGNOSIS

## TOP 3 Enrollment ERROR MESSAGES:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \text { \#1- Requisites NOT MET (28\%) } \\
& \text { \#2- UNIT LIMIT exceeded (24\%) } \\
& \text { \#3-TIME CONFLICT (23\%) }
\end{aligned}
$$

## \#1 Requisites NOT MET:

- Prerequisites - check UCSC coursework AND Transfer Credit tab
- Co-requisites - Is the student enrolling in all the required parts of a course?
- Check for major and/or class-level restriction
- May actually be a time conflict!


## \#2 UNIT LIMIT exceeded:

- TWO flavors:
- Unit limit exceeded for Appointment Period
- Maximum term Unit Load exceeded
- Most problematic with wait lists - don't just add, SWAP!


## \#3 TIME CONFLICT:

- Students can self-diagnose using the "weekly schedule"
- Remember: Requisites NOT MET can mask a time conflict

## Enrollment issues that require intervention:

## Enrollment Holds <br> Repeating credit

Triple repeats

## Enrollment Holds:

Enrollment holds appear in the student's MyUCSC Student Center - top of right column, above the To-Do List

Holds include all necessary information: who placed the hold, how to have it removed (even link to necessary forms!), and contact information

## Repeating Credit:

Students cannot enroll in a course they have already taken and passed, or in a course deemed equivalent to a course they have taken and passed.

Courses should only be repeated when there is academic need - repeating calculus as MATH 19A after taking MATH 11A.

To enroll in a repeat of credit, students must see their college advisor. ${ }^{* * *}$ subject to change***

## Triple Repeat:

The enrollment system will not allow students to enroll in a course for a third attempt; they will receive an error message:
"You have exceeded the allowable repeat limit for this course"

Repeating a course more than once requires college approval.
