Types of CREDIT:

- Units
- Test Credit
- Course Credit
- Subject Credit
- Major Credit
- Prerequisite Credit

UNITS:

- Units awarded for test scores and coursework
- Only Admissions can assign units to a student's record
- Max 105 quarter (70 semester) units of lower-division courses from non-UC
- Units can be awarded with or without a course equivalency:

AP Statistics score of 3 = 4 units, no course equivalency

TEST CREDIT:

- Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, or A-Level exams
- Units can be awarded for AP/IB or A-level exam scores
- Course equivalencies can be awarded for AP/IB exam scores, see <u>Admissions AP/IB Chart</u>
- Self-reported <u>vs</u> verified: only verified test credit applies for course equivalency and prerequisite credit

SUBJECT CREDIT:

- Students can still satisfy GE and university requirements after reaching the 105 quarter unit maximum
- Admissions reviews courses for subject credit
- Courses must be completed with passing grade, 2.0 or higher to qualify for subject credit

MAJOR CREDIT:

- Departments can grant major credit for test scores and/or coursework
- Courses must be completed with passing grade, 2.0 or higher to qualify for major credit (UCSC senate manual 10.2.2.1)
- Students should always have outside coursework approved for major credit prior to enrolling at another institution
- To request major credit, students should contact their major advisor
- REMINDER: The Disciplinary Communication requirement MUST be satisfied by courses taken at UCSC.

PREREQUISITE CREDIT:

- Departments can award prerequisite credit for test scores and/or completed coursework
- **Only Departments** can apply prerequisite credit to a student's record (enter Other Credit in AIS)
- Prerequisite credit (Other Credit) only facilitates enrollment
- To request prerequisite credit, students should contact their major advisor

EXAMPLE: Math Placement

Math Placement can be determined in three ways:

- AP or IB exam score (test credit)
- Credit for a college math course (course credit or prerequisite credit/Other Credit)
- An ALEKS assessment score (test credit)

Credit must be entered for students to enroll in math courses

EXAMPLE: Education Abroad Courses

- Admissions enters courses into student's transcript and awards units
- Student can request a Review of Transfer Credit to receive subject credit towards their GE or university requirements
- Departments can award credit towards the student's major requirements
- Departments can enter prerequisite credit for completed courses that apply towards future enrollment

EXAMPLE: UC Online Education Courses

- Courses now appear in UCSC transcript
- Admissions awards units
- Some UCOE courses articulated and carry a course equivalency
- Non-articulated courses can be submitted for Review of Transfer Credit
- Departments can award major credit
- Departments may need to enter prerequisite credit for future enrollment
