

**UC Santa Cruz Three year pathway: SOCIOLOGY  
2016-2017 Catalog Requirements**

Three year pathways are most appropriate for students who plan a single major, who have satisfied the Entry-Level Writing Requirement by the end of their first term, and who are committed to enrolling in Summer Session after their first and second years. Courses listed as “Any X credit class” may be decreased based on AP or other transfer credit.

This is a sample plan. Work with your major/program adviser to devise a plan that takes into account your transfer credit, interests, and career goals.
