

Students are admitted to UCSC with a "proposed major" in most cases, and later petition to officially declare the major. Admission to UCSC does not guarantee acceptance into a particular major. Junior transfer students must be officially declared in a major by the deadline in their second quarter of enrollment.

Major: ITALIAN STUDIES

Qualification requirements and/or prerequisites for the major:

- Students may declare the Italian studies major at any time.
- Transfer students should have completed two years of college-level Italian language study or the equivalent.

Transfer students who intend to pursue this major should do the following prior to the beginning of their first term...

Students who have taken college-level transferable classes that may apply to the requirements of this major should submit an unofficial transcript to the department prior to July 1. This transcript is in addition to the official transcript that is required by the UCSC Admissions Office.

...and should take these courses their first term:

Upper-division course on Italian topics in history, literature, or history of art and visual culture.

If unable to enroll in courses listed above:

Enroll in an alternate upper-division course on Italian topics in history, literature, or history of art and visual culture. Students may get in touch with an Italian studies adviser at litdept@ucsc.edu or 831-459-4778.

Skills important for success in this major:

Italian studies majors are required to complete two years of college-level Italian language study or the equivalent.

Although not required for the major, students in this major might benefit from these courses/ subjects:

Italian studies majors would benefit from taking courses in literature, history, or history of art and visual culture, including those not specifically on Italian topics.

Other information:

The Italian studies major is administered by the Literature Department.
