

Students are admitted to UCSC with a "proposed major" in most cases, and later petition to officially declare the major. Admission to UCSC does not guarantee acceptance into a particular major. Junior transfer students must be officially declared in a major by the deadline in their second quarter of enrollment.

Major: PSYCHOLOGY

Qualification requirements and/or prerequisites for the major:

Transfer students who listed Psychology as their intended major and who were admitted, have already been screened for qualification to the major. Students who are interested in declaring the Psychology major who did not list it on their applications should contact the Psychology Advising Office at psyadv@ucsc.edu.

Transfer students who intend to pursue this major should do the following prior to the beginning of their first term...

- ❑ Students who have taken college-level transferable classes that may apply to the requirements of this major should submit an unofficial transcript to the department prior to July 1. This unofficial transcript is in addition to the official transcript that is required by the UCSC Admissions Office.

...and should take these courses their first term:

- PSYC 100: *Research Methods in Psychology*, and
- PSYC 10: *Intro to Developmental Psychology* (if equivalent course was not taken at previous institution), or an upper division Psychology class (to be discussed with adviser)

If unable to enroll in courses listed above:

Skills important for success in this major:

Critical reading skills and analytical writing abilities.

Although not required for the major, students in this major might benefit from these courses/subjects:

PSYC 20 or PSYC 40. Any upper-division course in American Studies, Anthropology, Biological Sciences, Community Studies, Education, Feminist Studies, History of Consciousness, Latin American and Latino Studies, Linguistics, Philosophy, and Sociology.
