

Students are admitted to UCSC with a "proposed major" in most cases, and later petition to officially declare the major. Admission to UCSC does not guarantee acceptance into a particular major. Junior transfer students must be officially declared in a major by the deadline in their second quarter of enrollment.

**Major: SPANISH STUDIES**

Qualification requirements and/or prerequisites for the major:

Students must successfully complete Spanish 4 or SpHS 4 or have demonstrated equivalent proficiency, prior to declaring the major.

Transfer students who intend to pursue this major should do the following prior to the beginning of their first term...

Students should take the UCSC language placement exam as soon as possible.

...and should take these courses their first term:

- Linguistics 50: *Introduction to Linguistics*
- Spanish 4: *Second Year Spanish* or SpHS 4: *Spanish for Heritage Speakers*

If unable to enroll in courses listed above:

Enroll in an alternate class of your choosing, and sign up for the wait list when available.

Skills important for success in this major:

Critical reading skills and analytical writing abilities in Spanish and English.
