NEW STUDENT MAJOR ADVISING SUMMARY FOR 2018-2019 TRANSFER STUDENTS

Students are admitted to UCSC with a "proposed major" in most cases, and later petition to officially declare the major. Admission to UCSC does not guarantee acceptance into a particular major. Junior transfer students must be officially declared in a major by the deadline in their second quarter of enrollment.

Major: THEATER ARTS

Qualification requirements and/or prerequisites for the major:

Transfer students may declare the major with no prerequisites.

Transfer students who intend to pursue this major should do the following prior to the beginning of their first term...

Students who have taken college-level transferable classes that may apply to the requirements of this major should email an unofficial transcript to the undergraduate adviser (theater@ucsc.edu) before Summer Orientation, or bring them to a private pre-arranged meeting with the department adviser for review.

...and should take these courses their first term:

Any of the following, according to your interests and in consultation with the department adviser:

- THEA 10: *Introduction to Design* (THEA 10 is the prerequisite for further progress in technical/design courses)
- THEA 20: *Introductory Studies in Acting* (designed for students with little experience in acting); students with a good deal of acting experience should instead consider auditioning for THEA 21: *Acting Studio 1*
- THEA 61A: *Ancient and Medieval Drama*
- THEA 50: *Fundamentals of Theater Production* (2 credits)

Literary analysis, organizational skills, observational skills, communication, deductive reasoning, creativity

Other information:

Transfer students should declare the major during their first quarter on campus, after making an academic plan with the department adviser. Students are encouraged to make a study plan and update it quarterly together with the Department Adviser. Please email, call, or stop by the office to make an appointment.
